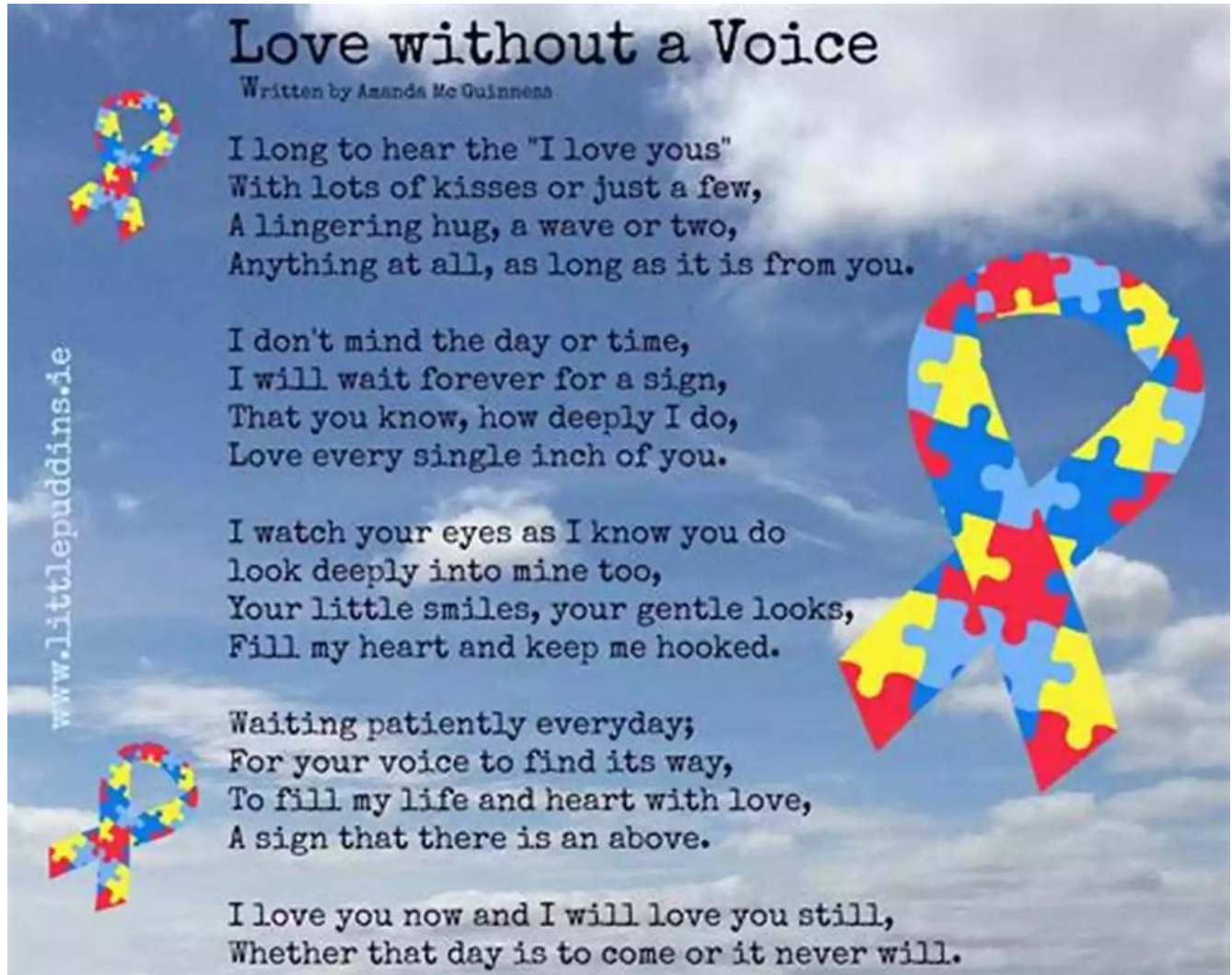


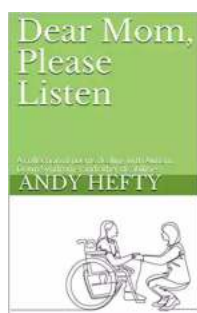

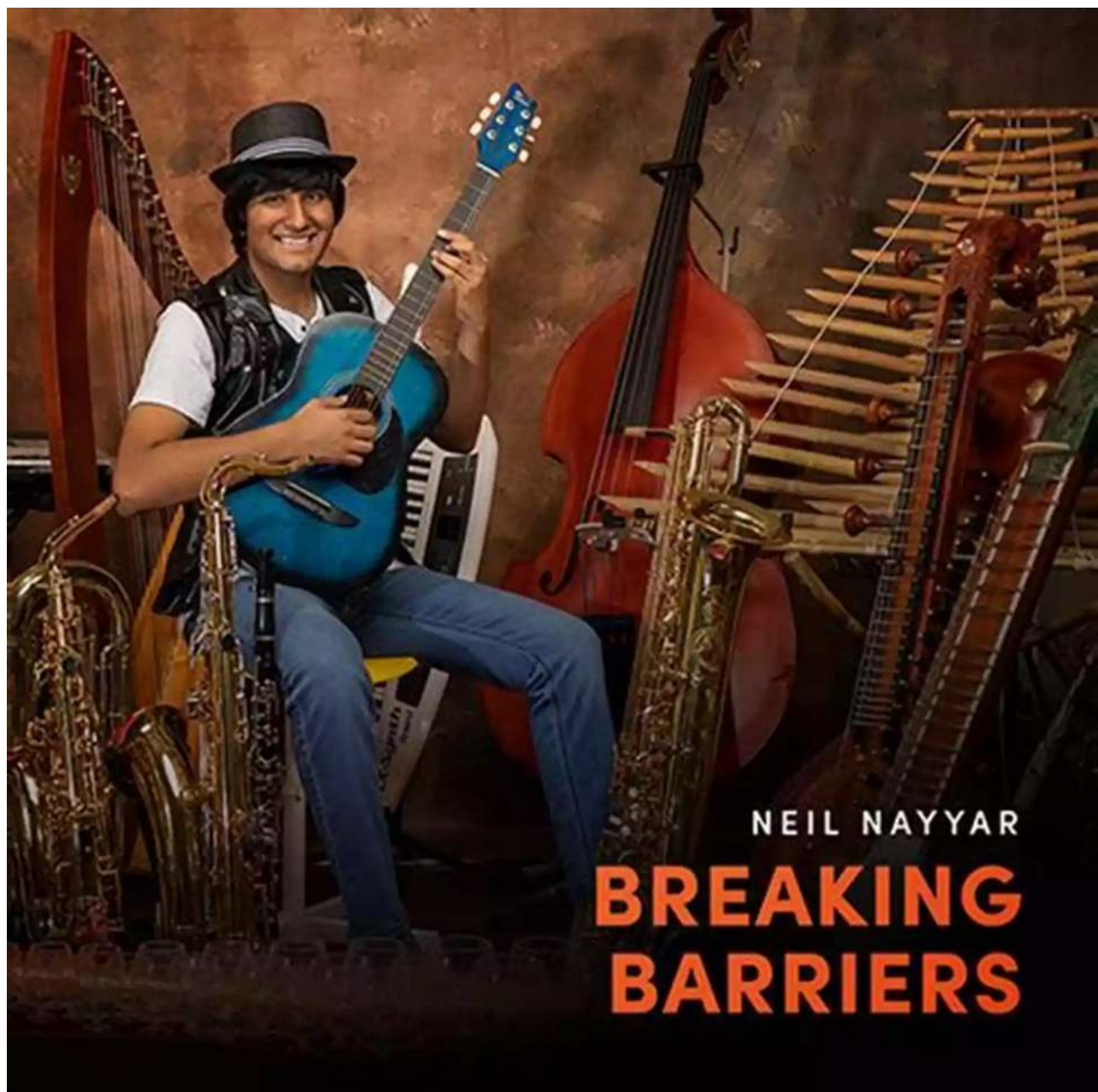

the powerful sensations start!

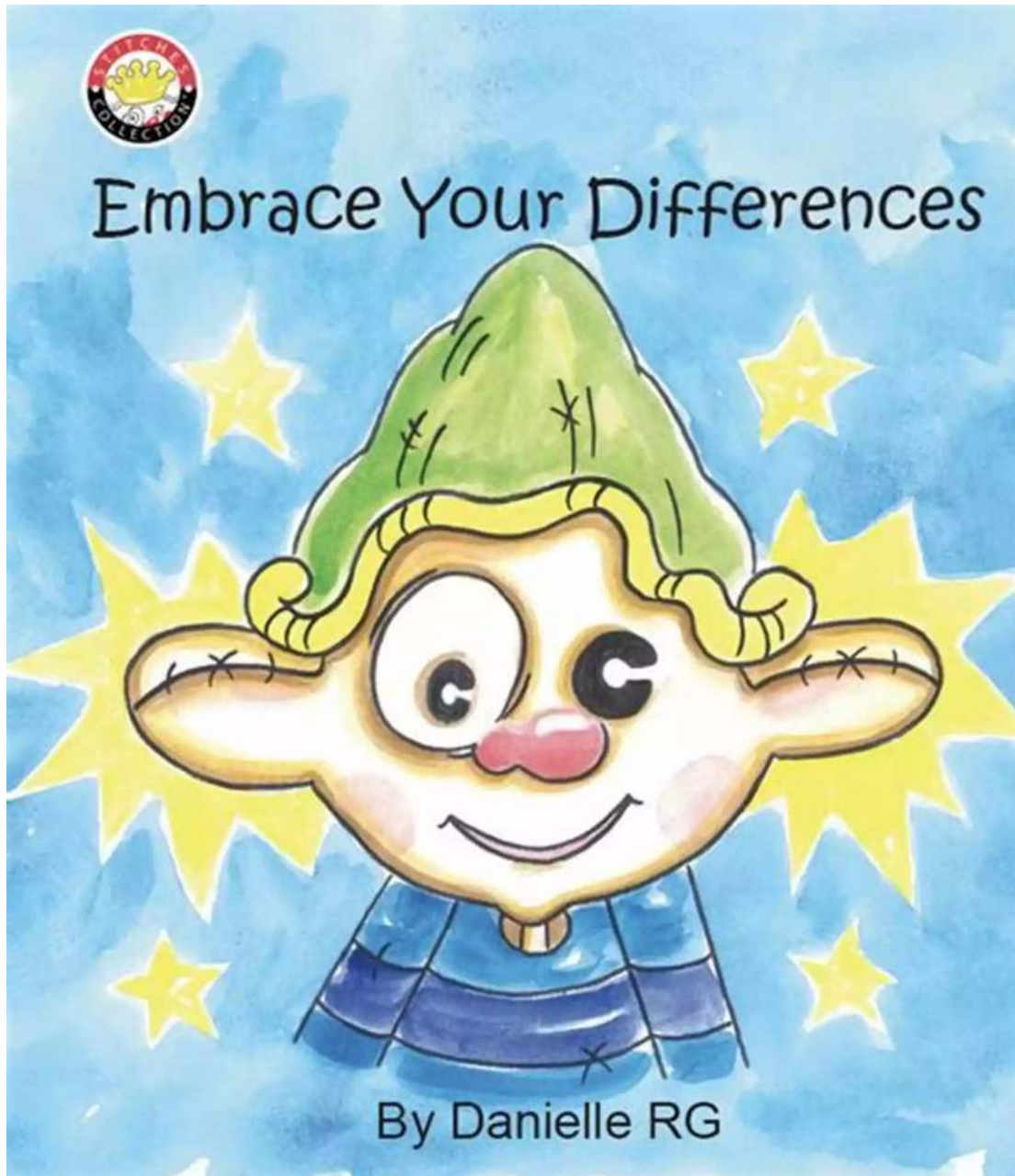
