great sequence flows freely from inside out at once in accordance with and in spirit of any given rhythmical form or rhyming pattern.



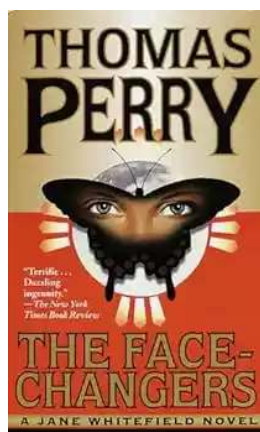
